

NEW DATA ON DISABILITY

In Canada, 2022

In 2022, 27.0% of Canada's aged 15 and older, 8.0 million people, had a disability. This is a 4.7 percentage point increase from 2017.


From 2017 to 2022, the disability rate rose



The disability rate increases with age. In 2017 and 2022, both men and women experience an increase in disability rate.

From 2017 to 2022, mental health-related, pain-related, and seeing difficulties made a significant contribution to the rise in Canada's disability rate.
