Dear Families of Elementary School Students

It has been a very different start up to school this year! It has been quite the journey for all of us as we return to learning in school or in our virtual program. We know that this year brings with it new rules, protocols, and routines. We are confident that if we continue to work together to follow the guidelines in place, we will position our whole community for the best possible chance of a successful, healthy school year.

As you are aware, families have made the decision to send their child back to a conventional classroom or to enroll their child in a remote/virtual learning program. For those families who have opted into the remote learning/virtual program, there will be designated times throughout the school year for a child to return to the classroom setting. The same is true for students in a conventional classroom who wish to opt into the remote learning/virtual program. The transition dates are as follows:

- Tuesday, October 13, 2020 with notification to the school by October 22, 2020
- Monday, November 9, 2020 with notification to the school by October 30, 2020
- Monday, February 1, 2021 with notification to the school by January 22, 2021
- Monday, March 22, 2021 with notification to the school by March 5, 2021

The first scheduled time period is fast approaching. Families who wish to transition must advise their child's home school by Friday, October 2, 2020. There will be no exceptions to this timeline. Changes to a student's attendance

program before you opt for this option during the ordered school closure. pm daily and attendance is taken twice
