NCDSB Boundary Review Process Public Meetings Set

New Liskeard , Cobalt, Temagami, October 8 , 2013:

The Northeastern Catholic District School Board Boundary Review Committee met on October 7 to review the Boundary Review Process, Terms of Reference, public consultation process and to schedule the Public meetings. As previously mentioned, the NCDSB has entered into a Boundary Review Process in the Temagami area, potentially affecting students currently attending both English Catholic Central School in New Liskeard and St. Patrick Catholic School in Cobalt.

The Boundary Review Process will ensure that the public has adequate opportunity to comment on the alternative solutions, that the impact on affected students has been considered and that the decisions are based on an efficient and equitable use of system resources. In most cases, the final approval of a boundary change rests with the Board of Trustees and would involve a full public consultation process, with recommendations coming from a Boundary Review Committee.
