The Boundary Review Process will ensure that the public has adequate opportunity to comment on the alternative solutions, the impact on affected students has been considered and that the decisions are based on an efficient and equitable use of system resources. All voting members of the BRG must attend a predetermined number of BRG meetings and public consultation sessions to be eligible to vote. This number will be set by the BRG chair at the beginning of the review. Should a parent representative be absent for a vote, that parent may submit their vote
