- 1.1 The process shall be in accordance with the governing legislation and other related provisions.
- 1.2 Upon receipt of a letter of resignation, the Board of Trustees shall be informed by the Director of Education at the first Public meeting of the Board after the cause is known.
- 1.3 A motion shall be made at a regular meeting of the Board declaring the office vacant.
- 2.1 Once the seat is vacant, a posting will be created by the Director of Education/designate and circulated to various media sources, including but not limited to newspapers, social media, radio, schools, and parish bulletins.
- 2.2 The posting remain open for a minimum of 2 weeks.
