DEFINITIONS

The following definitions are taken from Growing Success: Assessment, Evaluation, and Repc in Ontario Schools, 2010.

Assessment

The process of gathering, from a variety of sources, information that accurately reflects how well a student is achieving the curriculum expectation in a subject or course.

Assessment learning

The process of developing and supporting student metacognition.

Assessmentor learning

Evaluation

The process of judging the quality of student learning on the basis of established criteria and assigning a value to represent the quality. Evaluation is based on assess**ofeets** ning that provide data on student achievement at strategic times throughout the grade/subject/course, often at the end of a period of learning.
