## POLICY REGULATIONS

- 1.0 Provide for the oral administration of medication that has been prescribed for use during school hours and/or during school sanctioned supervised excursions, and where administration has been requested in writing by the parent/guardian, as confirmed byedioal practitioner.
- 2.0 Work in collaboration with community partners to secure services that must be provided by registered health practitioners under the Ministry of Health. These services include by are not limited to:
  - i) the injection of medication;
  - ii) catheterization;
  - iii) manual expression of the bladder/stoma;
  - iv) postural draining/suctioning;
